



































































































































































































































ICON NAME	ICON	RECOMMENDED USAGE
accessibility		A person inside a circle symbolizes web accessibility, which is used to indicate when an application or feature provides equal access to users with disabilities.
airplane-arrive		An airplane facing downward to the right symbolizes an arriving, incoming or inbound flight.
airplane-depart		An airplane facing upward to the right symbolizes a departing, outgoing or outbound flight. On a map, it may also be used as a location indicator for an airport.
airplane-swap		An airplane with two arrows pointing in opposite directions symbolizes a plane switch.
airplane		An airplane symbolizes a flight or, on a map, as a location indicator for an airport.
airplanes		Two airplanes overlapping each other symbolizes multiple flights.
alert-triangle		A triangle with an exclamation mark inside symbolizes a warning, messaging, or a notice that is important and should be read.
align-center		In a text editor, the "Center Text" symbol centers the text horizontally between the side margins.
align-justify		In a text editor, the "Left Justified" symbol stretches the lines of text so that each line has equal width.
align-left		In a text editor, the "Align Left" symbol aligns the text to the left margin.
align-right		In a text editor, the "Align Right" symbol aligns the text to the right margin.
announce		A megaphone symbolizes an announcement or message.
apple		An apple symbolizes food, fruit, or a snack.
archive		An archive box symbolizes an area to store documents, records, or files for possible retrieval at a later date.
arrow-basic-left		An arrow pointing to the left or a back arrow symbol is used in internet browsers or software to go backwards to a previous location.
arrow-basic-right		An arrow pointing to the right or a forward arrow symbol is used in internet browsers or software to go forward to the next location.
arrow-basic-up		An arrow pointing upward is a symbol used to move content up.
arrow-chevron-down		A chevron symbol that is pointing downward is used to expand a dropdown menu or panel.
arrow-chevron-left		A chevron symbol that is pointing to the left is used to expand or collapse a vertical menu or panel.
arrow-chevron-right		A chevron symbol that is pointing to the right is used to expand or collapse a vertical menu or panel.
arrow-chevron-up		A chevron symbol that is pointing upward is used to collapse a dropdown menu or panel.
arrow-curve-left		An arrow curving to the left will undo the previous action that was just completed.
arrow-curve-right		An arrow curving to the right will redo the previous action that was just completed.
arrow-double-horizontal		A horizontal line with arrowheads on either end symbolize an action to slide content from left to right.
arrow-double-vertical		A vertical line with arrowheads on either end symbolize an action to slide content up or down.
arrow-right-angle		An arrow that has a 90° angle symbolizes the hierarchy or "parent/child" relationship between two similar things.
arrow-triangle-down		A small triangle that is pointing downward is used to expand a dropdown menu, button, or panel; it may also be used in a filter to sort information.
arrow-triangle-left		A small triangle that is pointing to the left is used to expand or collapse a vertical menu, button, or panel.
arrow-triangle-right		A small triangle that is pointing to the right is used to expand or collapse a vertical menu, button, or panel.
arrow-triangle-up		A small triangle that is pointing upward is used to collapse a dropdown menu, button, or panel; it may also be used in a filter to sort information.
arrows-cross		Two intersecting arrows pointing in different directions symbolize an action to swap content from one location to another.
arrows-left-right		Two horizontal, parallel arrows pointing in different directions symbolize an action to exchange content from one location to another.
arrows-up-down		Two vertical, parallel arrows pointing in different directions symbolize an action to exchange content from one location to another.
arrows-update-alert		An update icon with an exclamation mark inside of it symbolizes an update alert or a notification about an update.








































arrows-update-pencil		An update icon with a pencil inside of it symbolizes an update that can be edited.
arrows-update		Two arrows rotating in a circle symbolizes the action of updating information.
art-cup		An art cup with a pencil, ruler, and paintbrush symbolizes a design element or an action to show a graphical user interface menu.
attachment		A paper clip symbolizes a file attachment.
ban		A circle with a line through it symbolizes cancellation, a stop, or ban; this symbol may be used on the top of another symbol.
bassinet		A bassinet symbolizes the area/seat where a bassinet hook is located on an airplane seat map.
bell		A bell symbolizes a notification or reminder.
boarding-pass		A boarding pass inside of a ticket jacket represents a pass for boarding an aircraft, given to a passenger when the ticket is issued or upon check-in at the airport.
bookmark		A bookmark symbolizes content that can be stored for later retrieval. This can also signify a favorite item, a shortcut or a specific customer level.
bookmark-star		A bookmark with a star in it symbolizes content of high preference or importance.
box-package		A box package symbolizes a product, service, or offering.
briefcase		A briefcase symbolizes a business or a location that may contain documents.
bus		A bus symbolizes the amenity of public transportation or, on a map, as a location indicator for a bus stop.
cable-car		A cable car symbolizes the amenity of public transportation or, on a map, as a location indicator for a cable car stop.
calendar-empty		An empty calendar symbolizes an option that allows the user to view available dates; it may also be used to change a calendar viewing method from day, week, etc.
calendar-star		A calendar with a star in it symbolizes a specific event or occasion.
calendar		A calendar symbolizes an option that allows the user to view a calendar, view date related information, or schedule an event.
camera		A camera icon symbolizes a tourist location or a designated location for a photo opportunity.
car-ferry		A car on a boat symbolizes a ferry, used to transfer a car across water.
car-parking		A car with a "P" in the upper-right hand corner symbolizes the amenity of car parking or, on a map, as a location indicator of available parking.
car-rental		A car with a key above it symbolizes the amenity of car rentals or, on a map, as a location indicator for a car rental facility.
check-circle		A check mark inside of a circle symbolizes an action is complete or that something is "OK".
check		A check mark symbolizes an action is complete or that something is "OK".
child-baby		A baby wrapped in a blanket symbolizes a passenger, guest or customer who is an infant.
child		A child silhouette symbolizes a passenger, guest or customer who is a child.
circles-connected		A set of connected circles symbolizes a set of related services.
clock		A clock symbolizes a time stamp, a specific time zone, an alarm clock, or a timer.
close-circle		An "X" inside of a circle symbolizes an action that will cancel an action, delete content, or close a panel, popover, or modal.
close		An "X" symbolizes an action that will cancel an action, delete content, or close a panel, popover, or modal.
cocktail		A cocktail glass symbolizes the availability of alcohol or the amenity of a mini-bar; it may also be used on a map as a location indicator for a bar.
coffee		A coffee mug symbolizes the availability of coffee, tea, or breakfast; it may also be used on a map as a location indicator for a coffee bar or restaurant.
cog-check		A cog with the check mark symbolizes a confirmation of configuration or settings update. This may also be used to differentiate a different type of configuration or setting from the cog icon.
cog		A cog or gear symbolizes a configuration or settings option.
congruent-cubes		A set of congruent cubes symbolizes a broad suite of products or services.
coupon		A coupon symbolizes a discount rate or discount code that can be applied to a price.
covid-19-virus		A virus particle with 3 circles inside symbolizes the COVID-19 virus. This may be used for COVID-19 information or to indicate the presence of the virus in a variety of situations.
credit-card-hand		A hand holding a credit card symbolizes the action of paying or a "local" form of payment.
credit-card-update		A credit card with the refresh icon symbolizes credit card information that needs to be updated.
credit-card		A credit card symbolizes a payment method using a credit or debit card.








































cruise		A cruise ship symbolizes a cruise vacation.
currency-convert		A currency converter icon symbolizes the exchange rate from one type of currency to another.
data-area		An area graph icon is used to display information graphically as an area chart.
data-bars		A bar graph icon is used to display information graphically as a bar chart.
data-line		A line graph icon is used to display information graphically as a line chart.
data-pie-chart		A pie chart icon is used to display information graphically as a pie chart.
design-dropper		An eyedropper symbolizes the ability to copy the style attributes of an element within a design program.
design-palette		A design palette symbolizes the ability to edit the style attributes of an element within a design program.
design-ruler-corner		A square with two rulers aligned in the corner symbolizes the measurement of a space or a design element.
diagram-category		A diagram of a single square above a group of squares symbolizes a category and the elements that comprise it.
diagram-flow		A flow diagram icon symbolizes a type of diagram that outlines a workflow or process.
diagram-tree		A tree diagram symbolizes a type of diagram that illustrates the hierarchical relationship between elements.
diagram-tree-reverse		A reverse tree diagram symbolizes a type of diagram that illustrates the hierarchical relationship between elements, beginning with the descendents.
diamond		A diamond symbolizes a status level; it may also be used to signify a special occasion i.e. anniversary or wedding.
document-cancel		A document with the close icon symbolizes a file or rate that has been cancelled or closed.
document-check		A document with a check mark symbolizes a file or rate that has been checked or verified.
document-checklist		A document with a check list on it symbolizes a task list, checklist, manifest or folio.
document-clock		A document with a clock symbolizes a timesheet or a time-sensitive document.
document-cog		A document with a cog symbolizes a configurable file or rate.
document-compress-zip		A document with a zipper on it symbolizes one or more files that have been compressed into a single archive file format.
document-font		A document with a capital "T" symbolizes a font file.
document-money		A document with a dollar sign symbolizes a financial statement or rate.
document-search		A document with a search icon symbolizes an action that allows a user to search or view a document.
document-share		A document with a share icon symbolizes an action that allows a user to share a document or rate with another.
document		A document symbolizes an electronic file that provides information or evidence or that serves as an official record.
documents-empty		Two empty documents symbolize a new document or the action of copying information or content.
documents		Two documents symbolize multiple electronic files.
dollar-symbol-circle		A dollar symbol inside of a circle symbolizes a paid or premium service, or an action related to money or finances.
duplicate		The duplicate icon symbolizes a user action that allows the user to create an exact replica of an existing file or document.
education-cap		The graduation cap icon symbolizes a training, certification, or formal education.
education		The graduate icon symbolizes someone who receives a diploma, degree, or certification.
electrical-plug		An electrical plug symbolizes a seat on an airplane that has an electrical outlet on an airplane seat map.
email-alert		An email icon with a warning symbol symbolizes a warning concerning a users' email permissions or email address.
email-search		A mail envelope with a magnifying glass symbolizes an action that allows a user to search through emails.
email		A mail envelope symbolizes the action of sending of an e-mail or to represent when e-mail is received.
employee-badge		An employee badge symbolizes the seat(s) where flight crew members are located on an airplane seat map.
ethernet		An ethernet port symbolizes the amenity of wired internet connection in a hotel room.
fax		A fax symbolizes a fax number or the amenity of a fax machine.
file-download		An arrow pointing down to a box symbolizes the downloading of a file.















file-upload		An arrow pointing up from a box symbolizes the uploading of a file.
flag		A flag symbolizes a warning or an important notification.
folder		A folder symbolizes an area capable of storing other files and folders.
folder-open		An open folder symbolizes the action of opening a file or an open folder in a file-menu structure.
food-service		A hand holding a platter symbolizes the amenity of a food service or fine dining.
food		A fork and knife symbolizes the amenity of food; it may also be used on a map as a location indicator for a restaurant.
games		A pair of dice symbolize games or entertainment.
gauge		A gauge symbolizes a visual display for measuring magnitude, amount, or contents of an element.
gift-card		A gift card symbolizes a form of payment using a prepaid stored-value money card usually issued by a retailer or bank.
gift		A gift box symbolizes a gift or reward; it may also be used to signify a guests' birthday.
hand-gift		A gift in a hand symbolizes an offer, gift, or reward.
handicap		The handicap icon symbolizes the amenity of ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) compliance.
headset		A headset icon symbolizes a communication tool that can be used to manage a telephone call or a call status.
history		An arrow rotating in a circle with clock hands inside symbolize an action that allows the user to view incremental changes that have occurred in the past.
home		A home or house icon symbolizes a method of getting to the main area or homepage.
hospital		A square with an "H" inside indicates the location of a hospital or medical facility.
hotel-ac		A thermometer with a snowflake symbolizes the amenity of an air conditioning system inside of a guest's room.
hotel-bathtub		A bathtub symbolizes the amenity of a bathtub inside of a guest's room.
hotel-bed-alert		A bed with a warning icon symbolizes a hotel room that is dirty and vacant.
hotel-bed-arrow-up		A bed with an arrow icon symbolizes an upgraded hotel room.
hotel-bed-ban		A bed with ban icon symbolizes a hotel room that is out of order.
hotel-bed-check		A bed with a check icon symbolizes a hotel room that is clean and vacant.
hotel-bed-close		A bed with close icon symbolizes a hotel room that is out of inventory.
hotel-bed-star		A bed with a star symbolizes a preferred hotel room.
hotel-bed		A bed symbolizes a hotel bed or a hotel room.
hotel-blow-dryer		A hair dryer symbolizes the amenity of a hairdryer within a guest's room.
hotel-check		A hotel building with a check mark symbolizes that a guest has checked into the hotel or is currently "in-house".
hotel-couch		A couch symbolizes the amenity of a sitting or lounge area inside of a guest's room.
hotel-fireplace		A fireplace symbolizes the amenity of a fireplace inside of a guest's room.
hotel-gym		A dumbbell symbolizes the amenity of a hotel fitness facility or gym.
hotel-iron		An iron symbolizes the amenity of an iron and/or ironing board inside of a guest's room.
hotel-key-card		An access key card with a key on it represents access control to hotel rooms, gyms, business centers, etc.
hotel-kitchen		A cooking pot symbolizes the amenity of a full kitchen or kitchenette inside of a guest's room.
hotel-lamp-desk		A desk lamp symbolizes the amenity of a desk lamp within a guest's room.
hotel-laundry		A washer/dryer machine symbolizes the amenity of a washer and/or dryer inside of a guest's room or the availability of laundry services.
hotel-microwave		A microwave symbolizes the amenity of a microwave inside of a guest's room.
hotel-night		A moon and stars symbolize an overnight hotel stay or a red-eye flight.
hotel-pool		A pool ladder symbolizes the amenity of a hotel pool, sauna, and/or steam room.
hotel-refrigerator		A refrigerator symbolizes the amenity of a refrigerator or minibar inside of a guest's room.

hotel-safe		A safe symbolizes the amenity of a safe within a guest's room.
hotel-shower		A shower head symbolizes the amenity of a separate shower.
hotel-spa		A head with a towel head wrap and cucumber over the eyes symbolizes the amenity of a hotel spa, sauna, and/or steam room.
hotel		A hotel building symbolizes the location of an establishment providing accommodations, meals, and other services for travelers and tourists.
info-circle		A lowercase "i" inside of a circle allows a user to access additional information, details, or view frequently-asked-questions.
key		A key symbolizes a room key, car key, or user access.
layout-header		A narrow horizontal rectangle on top of a taller rectangle symbolizes a layout with a header.
layout-header-2-column		A narrow horizontal rectangle on top of 2 vertical rectangles symbolizes a layout with a header and 2 content columns.
layout-header-3-column		A narrow horizontal rectangle on top of 3 vertical rectangles symbolizes a layout with a header and 3 content columns.
layout-header-sidebar-left		A narrow horizontal rectangle on top of 2 vertical rectangles, with a thin vertical rectangle positioned on the left, symbolizes a layout with a header and a left-aligned sidebar.
layout-header-sidebar-right		A narrow horizontal rectangle on top of 2 vertical rectangles, with a thin vertical rectangle positioned on the right, symbolizes a layout with a header and a right-aligned sidebar.
leaf		A leaf symbolizes green or eco-friendly amenities.
lightning-bolt		A lightning bolt symbolizes an air, hotel, or car flash rate.
link		Two circles or ovals that are connected to each other that resemble a chain symbolizes a link or a hyperlink.
link-unlink		Two half-circles or ovals that are separated with action lines symbolizes the action of unlinking a hyperlink or the presence of a broken hyperlink.
location-ban		A location indicator with a ban symbol in it symbolizes a location that is out of policy.
location-check		A location indicator with a check mark in it symbolizes a location that is verified.
location-empty		An empty location indicator symbolizes generic location indicator; the icon may be used by itself or with smaller icons placed inside of it.
location-information		A location indicator with an "i" in it symbolizes information on a location.
location-star		A location indicator with a star in it symbolizes a preferred location on a map.
location		A location indicator with a circle in it symbolizes a specific location on a map; it is used as the default location finder icon.
locations-connected		Three location indicators connected symbolize point-to-point directions or a multi-destination trip.
lock-close		A locked padlock symbolizes when anything is locked or secure.
lock-open		An unlocked padlock symbolizes when anything is unlocked or unsecure.
lounge-chair-sun		A sun and lounge chair symbolizes a vacation, beach amenity, or leisure.
map		A map with a location indicator symbolizes an option that allows the user to view a map.
math-add-circle		A plus sign inside of a circle symbolizes the action of increasing, adding, or zooming in on software programs and hardware devices.
math-add		A plus sign symbolizes the action of increasing, adding, or zooming in on software programs and hardware devices.
math-equals		The "equals sign" symbolizes equality in a mathematical equation.
math-subtract-circle		A minus symbol inside of a circle symbolizes the action of decreasing, removing, or zooming out on software programs and hardware devices.
math-subtract		A minus symbol symbolizes the action of decreasing, removing, or zooming out on software programs and hardware devices.
menu-ellipsis-horizontal		Three dots aligned horizontally symbolizes an action to show more content or present a menu.
menu-ellipsis-vertical		Three dots aligned vertically symbolizes an action to show more content or present a menu.
menu-hamburger		Three horizontal lines above each other are known as the "hamburger menu" and symbolizes a menu.
merge		Two arrow lines that merge into one symbolizes the action of merging two elements into one.
message-airplane		A speech bubble with an airplane inside symbolizes a message that pertains to a flight.
message-chat		Two speech bubble symbols indicate a two-way conversation or chat.
message-info		A speech bubble with an "i" inside symbolizes a message that contains additional information or more details.
message-star		A speech bubble with a star inside symbolizes an important message.

message		A speech bubble symbol is used in communications to indicate there is a message that needs to be read or that someone is typing a message.
microphone		A microphone symbolizes voice-enabled technology or the ability to record.
money		A dollar bill symbolizes any form of currency i.e. banknotes and coins.
monitor-binary		A monitor displaying binary digits symbolizes code, code samples, or a code library.
move-left-right		Two opposing arrows split vertically with two lines symbolizes the action of resizing a table's column width; it may also be used to move content up or down.
move-up-down		Two opposing arrows split horizontally with two lines symbolizes the action of resizing a table's row height; it may also be used to move content left or right.
museum		A column or pillar symbolizes the location of a museum or art gallery.
note		A document with a pencil symbolizes a notation or annotation.
out		An arrow going out of a square symbolizes the action of a user signing out of a site or application.
pacifier		A pacifier symbolizes the seat where an infant is located on an airplane seat map.
paper-airplane		A paper airplane symbolizes the action of sharing or sending content i.e. email, documents, etc.
passport		A passport symbolizes a travel document or a form of identification.
password-hide		An open eye with a line going through it symbolizes that content is currently not visible.
password-view		An open eye symbolizes that content is currently visible.
pencil		A pencil is used in graphic and image editors as one method of drawing on the picture or canvas; it may also be used to indicate that editing is available.
pet-paw		A paw print symbolizes the amenity that pets are allowed on the premises.
phone-clock		A phone receiver with a clock symbolizes a wake-up call (a telephone call from a hotel employee to a sleeping guest).
phone-hang-up		A phone receiver with an arrow pointing towards it symbolizes the action of ending a call.
phone-mobile		A mobile phone symbolizes a handheld cellular mobile device.
phone		A phone receiver symbolizes a telephone number or a telephone call.
picture		A single image icon symbolizes a visual design such as a painting, drawing, or photography.
pictures		Two image icons symbolize multiple visual designs such as paintings, drawings, or photography.
piggy-bank		A piggy bank symbolizes a bank form of payment i.e. checking account, savings account, etc.
power-button		A power button symbol is used around any button that is used to turn on or off a device.
print		A printer is used as an action to print a page or open a print preview.
pushpin		A pushpin is used to pin an item to the top of a list or save an item for future reference.
question-mark-circle		A question mark inside of a circle allows a user to access help or online documentation.
question-mark		A question mark symbol allows a user to access help or online documentation.
rate-loading		A dollar sign inside of a refresh icon symbolizes a rate that is loading.
receipt		A receipt symbolizes a written acknowledgement of having received a specified amount of money, goods, etc.
refresh		An arrow going in a circle is a symbol often used to indicate a reload or refresh.
resize-max		Four arrows that point outward in opposite directions symbolize the action of resizing a window or panel to the maximum width and height.
resize-restore		Four arrows that point inward to a central point symbolizes the action of resizing a window or panel to its original width and height.
restroom		The restroom icon symbolizes the amenity of restroom or, on a map, as a location indicator of a restroom.
save		An arrow that points downward into a square symbolizes the action of saving a file, document, or progress.
search-globe-airplane		A globe, airplane, and magnifying glass symbolize a global flight or trip search.
search		A magnifying glass is used to represent a search functionality; it may also be used to zoom in/out on specific content.
seat		A single seat symbolizes an individual seat on some type of public transportation i.e. airline seat.
service-bell		A service bell symbolizes front desk service, a concierge, or guest registration. It may also be used as an action to contact a front desk area.

share		Three solid circles connected by two lines is the symbol that is often used to represent a social network sharing link on websites.
shield-check		A check mark inside of a shield symbolizes a security check.
shopping-cart		A shopping cart symbolizes a aggregation of selections that can be purchased. Items are added to the shopping cart that can be edited later or checked out when done shopping.
sign-in-clock		The sign-in icon with a clock symbolizes the anticipation of a guest check-in.
sign-in		An arrow going into a rectangle or "door" symbolizes the action of a user signing into a site or application; it may also be used to indicate that a guest has "checked in."
sign-out		An arrow going out of a rectangle or "door" symbolizes the action of a user signing out of a site or application; it may also be used to indicate that a guest has "checked out."
sliders		A slider icon symbolizes a control that can be used to adjust the settings or values of an element; it may also be used as a filter representing a set of options being reduced to a smaller number of options
smoking-non		A lit cigarette with a line going through it symbolizes that smoking is not allowed.
smoking		A lit cigarette symbolizes that smoking is allowed.
social-facebook		The Facebook icon will link the user to the Facebook site or application.
social-flickr		The Flickr icon will the user to the Flickr site or application.
social-instagram		The Instagram icon will link the user to the Instagram site or application.
social-linkedin		The LinkedIn icon will link the user to the LinkedIn site or application.
social-pinterest		The Pinterest icon will the user to the Pinterest site or application.
social-twitter (deprecated)		The Twitter icon will link the user to the Twitter site or application.
social-wechat		The WeChat icon will link the user to the WeChat site or application.
social-x		The X icon will link the user to the X site or application.
social-youtube		The YouTube icon will link the user to the YouTube site or application.
sort		Progressively smaller lines symbolizes a sorted list.
sparkle		Three diamonds of various sizes symbolizes something that is new or clean.
split		A single arrow line that splits into two symbolizes the action of splitting an element into two.
spray-bottle		A spray bottle symbolizes enhanced cleaning, typically associated with hotel services.
star		A star symbolizes a preference, a symbol of importance, or high quality standard.
store		A storefront symbolizes a business or store. It may also be used to represent a group of people i.e. clients or buyers.
suitcase		A suitcase symbolizes luggage or bags that a guest is travelling with.
sweep		A sweeping broom symbolizes cleaning or making things tidy, typically associated with hotel services.
tablet		A tablet icon symbolizes a handheld tablet device.
tag-alert		A tag with a warning icon symbolizes a warning or notification about a rate.
tag-calendar		A tag with a calendar icon symbolizes rate that applies to a specific date or date range.
tag-eye		A tag with an eye icon symbolizes a rate that is visible.
tag-lock		A tag with a lock icon symbolizes a locked rate.
tag-pencil		A tag with a pencil icon symbolizes the editing of a rate.
tag-star		A tag with a star icon symbolizes a preferred rate.
tag-update		A tag with an update icon symbolizes the updating or refresh of a rate.
tag		A tag icon symbolizes a rate, an add-on, or a metadata tag.
tags		Two tags symbolizes multiple rates, add-ons, or metadata tags.
taxi		A taxi icon symbolizes the amenity of public transportation or, on a map, as a location indicator for a car service pick-up/drop-off location.
terminal		A terminal icon symbolizes a command line interface or developer code.
text-large		Overlapping text, with the large letter in front, symbolizes an action that makes text larger.

text-small		Overlapping text, with the small letter in front, symbolizes an action that makes text smaller.
theater		The "theatre masks" symbolize the location of a theatre or performing arts center.
ticket		A ticket icon symbolize the ability to enter a place, travel by public transport, or participate in an event.
tools		A wrench and screwdriver symbolizes an area to adjust settings or other options.
toy-building-block		A building block symbolizes a component or product that can build upon itself or integrate seamlessly into a broader set.
train		A train icon symbolizes the amenity of public transportation or, on a map, as a location indicator for a train or rail system stop.
trash		A trash can or recycle bin symbolizes the deletion of a file or another object on the screen and may be a container for any deleted items.
trophy-minus		A trophy with a minus sign symbolizes the subtraction of an award or reward.
trophy-plus		A trophy with a plus sign symbolizes the addition of an award or reward.
trophy		A trophy with a star symbolizes an award or reward.
upc-code		The UPC code icon symbolizes a UPC barcode.
user-alert		A user icon with a warning symbol indicates a warning or notification about a user, guest, or profile; it may also be used to symbolize a hotel room that is dirty and occupied.
user-ban		A user icon with a ban symbol indicates the restriction of permissions or user access.
user-check		A user icon with a check mark indicates a verification about a user, guest, or profile; it may also be used to symbolize a hotel room that is clean and occupied.
user-documents		A user icon with a document indicates a user's or guest's document i.e. records, passports, visas, etc.
user-identification-check		A user identification card with a check mark symbolizes that identification has been checked or verified.
user-identification		A user identification card symbolizes the identification of a guest i.e. driver's license or passport.
user-search		A user icon with a magnifying glass symbolizes an action that allows the search of a user, guest, or profile.
user		A silhouette of one adult symbolizes a single user, guest, or profile; it may also be used to signify when a hotel or cruise room is occupied.
users-global		A group of users with a globe symbolizes a governing body of people or a large group of users across multiple locations.
users-swap		The users icon with two arrows pointing in opposite directions symbolizes an action that allows two users to exchange duties, schedules, roles, etc.
users		A silhouette of two adults symbolizes multiple users, guests, or profiles.
video-playback		A video playback icon symbolizes the amenity of a movie screen on a flight or a seat(s) where individual screens are located on an airplane seat map.
video-control-forward		Two triangles that point to the right symbolizes the fast forward function in audio and video media players.
video-control-pause		Two vertical lines symbolizes the pause function in audio and video media players.
video-control-play		A large, single triangle that points to the right symbolizes the play function in audio and video media players.
video-control-rewind		Two triangles that point to the left symbolizes the rewind function in audio and video media players.
video-control-stop		A solid small box symbolizes the stop function in audio and video media players.
video		A video camera icon symbolizes a video media player or the capability to record videos.
view-grid-2x2		Four squares evenly spaced symbolizes a user action that changes the view of contents into a 2x2 grid.
view-grid-3x3		Nine squares evenly spaced symbolizes a user action that changes the view of contents into a 3x3 grid.
view-list		Three squares aligned with three rectangles symbolizes a user action that changes the view of contents into a list.
weather-clouds		Two clouds symbolize very cloudy weather conditions.
weather-cloudy		A cloud symbolizes cloudy weather conditions.
weather-day-cloudy		A cloud and a sun symbolize cloudy weather conditions during the day.
weather-day-rain		A cloud, sun, and angled lines symbolize rainy weather conditions during the day.
weather-day-sleet		A cloud, sun, and angled lines capped with dots symbolize sleet or freezing rain during the day.
weather-day-snow		A cloud, sun, and small dots symbolize snowy weather conditions during the day.
weather-day-storm		A cloud, sun, and a lightning bolt symbolize a rainstorm during the day.

weather-day-sunny		A sun symbolizes sunny weather conditions.
weather-mist		A cloud with parallel lines underneath symbolizes misty weather conditions.
weather-night-clear		A moon symbolizes clear weather conditions at night.
weather-night-cloudy		A cloud and a moon symbolize cloudy weather conditions at night.
weather-night-rain		A cloud, moon, and angled lines symbolize rainy weather conditions at night.
weather-night-sleet		A cloud, moon, and angled lines capped with dots symbolize sleet or freezing rain at night.
weather-night-snow		A cloud, moon, and small dots symbolize snowy weather conditions at night.
weather-night-storm		A cloud, moon, and a lightning bolt symbolize a rainstorm at night.
weather-rain		A cloud with angled lines symbolizes rainy weather conditions.
weather-sleet		A cloud with angled lines capped dots symbolizes sleet or freezing rain.
weather-snow		A cloud with small dots symbolizes snowy weather conditions.
weather-storm		A cloud with a lightning bolt symbolizes a rainstorm.
wifi		The Wi-Fi, or wireless network, icon symbolizes the amenity or availability of public internet service.
world		A globe may symbolize global access, internet access, language or keyboard options, or public access.
